



LLANTWIT MAJOR

- Exit the M4 at Junction 33
- · Take the A4232 signposted "Cardiff Bay"
- · Turn off at signpost for A48 the airport
- Take the fourth exit from the roundabout signposted A48 Cowbridge
- You should go through a set of traffic lights with Marks and Spencers on your right and McDonalds on your left
- · Stay on this road for approx 8 miles
- · Go through St Nicholas & Bonvilston
- After about 8 miles you should pass the turning for Cowbridge and a BP petrol station on your right. The road changes to a dual carriageway.

- Turn left onto the B4270 signposted Llantwit Major
- · Go through Llysworney
- Straight ahead at the first roundabout follow signs for the town centre. You are now entering Llantwit Major indicated by the purple A on the map opposite.
- Drive down High Street and follow the road round to the left (indicated by the purple B)
- At the roundabout, turn right. At the next roundabout turn right.
- Turn left into Church Street. Try and find somewhere to park!



ST DONATS ART CENTRE, ST DONATS

FROM ST ILLTUD'S CHURCH

- Follow Church Street round until the T-Junction of Dimlands Road and West Street (indicated by the purple A on the map opposite)
- · Turn left into Dimlands Road
- Drive for approx. IO minutes until you come to an abrupt right turn. You should see a lodge house and a signpost for the St Donats Art Centre and Atlantic College (indicated by the purple C on the map opposite).
- Follow the road into the grounds to the car park

FROM B4270

- Turn right at the large roundabout signposted to Bridgend
- Drive for about 10 minutes until you see a brown sign for Atlantic College and St Donats Art Centre (indicated by the purple B on the map opposite)
- Turn left
- Follow the road for about 5 minutes (this is quite a rural road, you'll think you're lost, but you're not!)
- · You should come to a T-Junction. Turn left.
- · Drive past a few houses. This is St Donats.
- After a couple of minutes you should reach an abrupt left turn where you turn right into the Art Centre and College grounds.

OTHER INFORMATION

TRANSPORT

The nearest train stations from Llantwit Major are in Barry (9 miles – a Valleys Line station) and Bridgend (9 miles – on the First Great Western London to Swansea –via Cardiff- train route).

The airport is approximately 5 miles from Llantwit Major. There's a very limited bus service to Llantwit Major and slightly more frequent buses to Cowbridge, Barry and Bridgend all from Cardiff.

Llantwit Major is a small town and this part of the Vale is fairly rural and we'd recommend getting around by car or taxi.

The traffic on the M4 (the main motorway in and out of South Wales) through Newport and Cardiff can get really busy especially if there's football on in Cardiff so leave plenty of time.

Llantwit Major is approximately 30-40 minutes drive from Junction 33 of the M4.
